

CONFESSION OF SINS

M: Dear brothers and sisters in Christ: The Lord has given us a great treasure in the Bible. It was inspired by the Holy Spirit, preserved for us down through the centuries, and is provided for us in modern translations. Though we recognize that we have received a treasure in the Scriptures, we have also neglected them and lived contrary to them. We struggle against a sinful nature in us which despises the Word. Let us confess our sins to the Lord and, trusting in his mercy, ask for his Holy Spirit to help us be more faithful learners and doers of the Word of God.

C: Almighty and merciful Father, we confess our sins to you. We have despised your words, and disobeyed your commands in our actions, words, and thoughts. Lord, show us mercy. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

ABSOLUTION

M: Since you have humbly confessed your sins before Almighty God, be strengthened in faith, remembering that he does not want any sinner to die, but would rather have him turn from his evil ways and live. God has commanded his called ministers to declare the forgiveness of sins to all who are penitent. Rest assured, therefore, that your sins have been covered up by the blood and righteousness of Jesus Christ, your Savior. May God's peace be with you.

THE WORD

GOSPEL Matthew 16:21-26

Last week, we listened as Matthew recorded a beautiful confession by Peter of who Jesus is. No doubt the disciples understood who Jesus was. But they failed to understand his work. When Jesus speaks clearly about his cross, Peter spoke Satan's words of compromise. Thanks be to God that our Savior saw the necessity of the cross before the crown.

²¹ From that time, Jesus began to show his disciples that he had to go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders, chief priests, and experts in the law, and be killed, and on the third day be raised again.

²² Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, "May you receive mercy, Lord! This will never happen to you."

²³ But Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a snare to me because you are not thinking the things of God, but the things of men."

²⁴Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone wants to follow me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. ²⁵In fact whoever wants to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. ²⁶After all, what will it benefit a person if he gains the whole world, but forfeits his soul? Or what can a person give in exchange for his soul?



DEVOTION (10:45 am)

^{18b} Yes, and I will continue to rejoice, ¹⁹ because I know that this will turn out for my deliverance, through your prayer and the support of the Spirit of Jesus Christ. ²⁰ This matches my earnest expectation and hope that I will in no way be put to shame, but with all boldness, as always, so even now, Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. ²¹ Yes, for me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. ²² But if I am to go on living in the flesh, that will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet which should I prefer? I do not know. ²³ I am pulled in two directions, because I have the desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far. 24 But, it is more necessary for your sake that I remain in the flesh. ²⁵ And since I am convinced of this, I know that I will remain and will continue with all of you, for your progress and joy in the faith. ²⁶ And so by my coming to you again, my goal is to give you even more reason to boast in Christ Jesus.


