
A REAL CHRISTMAS WILL LIFT UP THE LOWLY

My sacrifice, O God, is a broken spirit;


a broken and contrite heart you, God, will not despise.


For I know my transgressions,







ABSOLUTION



through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.


OFFERING


