OUR CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION: CHRIST THE SAVIOR IS BORN

The loved and peaceful Christmas Song “Silent Night” paints the picture of the incarnation. The last phrase is repeated, so in the second stanza we hear it twice: “Christ the Savior is born!” Every word of that phrase is significant, and every line of the Christmas carol describes a Bible truth. We use the beloved hymn to ponder the profound message of Christmas.



“LOVE’S PURE LIGHT BEAMS FROM THY HOLY FACE”

Today, we celebrate the Festival of the Epiphany (traditionally January 6). Epiphany comes from a Greek word meaning “reveal.” When the Savior was born, he was first revealed as *love’s pure light* to Israelites: Mary, Joseph, the shepherds. Today, we see the Lord miraculously guiding foreigners across countless miles so the Savior’s holy face could be revealed to them as well. The Festival of Epiphany is sometimes known as Christmas for the Gentiles. We Gentiles (non-Jews) rejoice in the good news that this Jewish baby is a gift for all people, Christ the Savior of the world.

Those preparing their hearts to receive holy communion may reflect on the questions and answers found on p. 295-296 in the blue hymnal.

CONFESSTION

Dear friends: Jesus Christ is the Light of the world. The darkness of the world is human sin and spiritual ignorance. Into this world of spiritual darkness and ignorance we were born as sinners. Though we have been given the light of life and forgiveness through faith in Jesus, in our daily struggle against sin we have slipped into the deeds of darkness. Let us confess this to the Lord and be forgiven through his grace.

Lord of Light and Love: We confess our sins to you this day. You know the dark thoughts that we have had. You have heard the shameful words we have spoken. You have seen the hurtful things we have done. Have mercy on us, O Lord. Forgive our sins and renew us in the Light of hope and forgiveness.

ABSOLUTION

The Lord is merciful and full of compassion. In his mercy, he has given us the light and joy of forgiveness. Because of Jesus' suffering on the cross for us, because of his perfect life in our place, and demonstrated by his resurrection from death on Easter morning, God has declared us forgiven. So rejoice and sing, for joy as you receive the Lord's own promise: Whoever believes and is baptized shall be saved. I forgive you in the name of the Father and of the Son + and of the Holy Spirit.
